In event of this Permittee wishing to transfer ownership of the specimen(s) to another person, the recipient person must first apply for and be granted a new permit in their own name, and the transfer shall not involve any remuneration. • In event of relocation of the specimen(s) under the same ownership, the Permittee must advise DoE of the new location address prior to the move. Specimens may not be relocated between the Islands. • National Conservation Act Permits are granted for a maximum of two-years and DoE may, upon expiration, perform scheduled follow-up housecalls at the above address before renewing the Permit.
